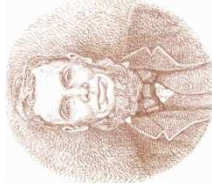

## Kinross (Marshall) Museum



David Marshall (1831-1902), a noted Kinross antiquarian, archivist and collector left, in his will of 1869 all his "historical Books, Manuscript Collections in Natural History and Antiquities" to the people of Kinross. In 1903 the Trustees of David Marshall handed over his collections to Kinross Town Council with a view to a museum being created in the new Carnegie Library and for a few years some items were put on display there. It was not until 1974 that the Joint Library Committee of the Town and County Councils of Kinross was able to mount a full display with the assistance of the Kinross-shire Antiquarian Society (now the Kinross-shire Historical Society).

Subsequently supervised by Perth Museum and art Gallery under the authority of Perth and Kinross District Council, the museum remained open until its closure by the new Perth and Kinross Council in 1996. In that year the Kinross (Marshall) Museum Trust was founded under the chairmanship of the late Mrs Nan Walker, MBE, its aim being the reopening and effective management of the museum for the benefit of the community and the education of the general public.

In 2009 the Kinross Museum found a permanent home along with the Public Library in the new Loch Leven Community Campus.
